Do not attempt to travel with a document that you have reported as lost or stolen.





You declare your travel document (passport, ID card, etc) as lost or stolen to local police.





Your country **cancels** the document. It is considered invalid.



The details of the lost/stolen document are **passed on to INTERPOL.**







INTERPOL records the document in its Stolen and Lost Travel Document (SLTD) database, which is accessible to its 190 member countries.



Border officials can screen

passenger information
directly against the SLTD
database. Selected carriers can
submit the document details
through I-Checkit for screening.







Entry or boarding is denied. The travel document is seized to prevent its future use.

You cannot travel.
